Requirement for Application:

1. Membership:

- A minimum of continuous 7 years of membership with HKIA, OR
- A minimum of continuous 7 years of membership with ARBHK as a Registered Architect

AND

2. Experience:

- At least 7 years of experience in project management (experience from both local and overseas projects is accepted):
 - Experience prior to acquiring HKIA full membership may count, but at least 5 years must be post-membership.
 - Experience can be as a project manager for a developer/client or as a manager in a consultancy firm.
 - 'Full project cycle' experience is required, which can be accumulated from various projects at different stages as defined under the HKIA consultancy agreement.

- Please note that the application fee HK\$1,000 is non-refundable in all circumstances.
- All applications will have to be vetted by HKIA. The corresponding parties, including project management accreditation committee, BEdA and the HKIA Council, will review the applicant's experience, and final approval of the application for registration rests with the HKIA Council.
- Applicants' particular may be released to third parties for confirmation of the academic and professional qualifications, as well as the experiences.
