Canberra Accord Periodic Review The Canberra Accord Periodic Review was conducted in conjunction with the accreditation visit to The Chinese University of Hong Kong in June 2025. Following the submission of the Self-Evaluation Report, the Canberra Accord Review Panel carried out its evaluation. This mandatory exercise is conducted regularly following admission into the Canberra Accord to maintain international recognition of the architectural programmes, and HKIA has been accepted as a signatory member of the Canberra Accord for a further five years at the Canberra Accord Interim Meeting 2026.

Professional Assessment (PA)	<u>PA 2025 1st Professional Interview – 25 March 2026</u> The Professional Interview was held on 25 March 2026 at Harbour Grand Hotel, North Point for NLAP applicants and PA candidates respectively. a) Professional Interview for NLAP applicants There is 1 Group B applicant eligible for the Professional Interview, and the applicant passed the Interview. b) Professional Interview for PA candidates There are 136 fresh and 20 re-sit candidates enrolled for the Professional Interview. There were 13 Panels for the Interview with 42 Interviewers. Out of 154 candidates (exclude 2 absent candidates), 112 candidates (73.68%) passed the interview. The passing rate is similar to last year (77.66% in March 2025). 2	ARCASIA 23 rd Forum in India	<u>ARCASIA 23rd Forum in India</u> Date: 7 –13 September 2026 Venue: Delhi, Jaipur & Agra (India's iconic Golden Triangle) Main Theme: "Bringing Back... Vernacular Wisdom" HKIA will be organising a delegation to the 23rd ARCASIA Forum with funding support applied for under the PASS Professionals Participation Subsidy Programme (PSP) via the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office (HKETO) in Singapore. Following the approval of a 50-participant quota, a joint EOI was issued on 5 June 2026 across four professional institutes: HKIA, HKIP, HKILA, and HKIS. Curated around the main theme, "Bringing Back... Vernacular Wisdom", the forum will be held across India's iconic Golden Triangle (Delhi, Jaipur, and Agra). Major events include the Forum Conference, ARCASIA Committee and Council meetings, an Awards Night dinner, Friendship Night, and site visit tours. The proposed PSP travel period will take place from 7 to 14 September 2026 (7 nights), including round-trip flights between Hong Kong and Delhi. Due to regional safety considerations, participants are strongly advised to adhere strictly to the official itinerary; consequently, no auxiliary activities will be organised by HKIA within the programme.
3.	Fontainebleau Schools Summer Programme 2026	The Fontainebleau Schools organise an annual summer programme for students specialising in music, composition, fine arts, and architecture. The curriculum explores the synergy between architectural traditions and contemporary experimental urbanism and landscape design. This intensive five-week session is open to Bachelor and Master of Architecture students. It emphasises drawing as a primary tool for observation and fosters multidisciplinary collaboration between architects and musicians. The 2026 session will run from 28 June to 29 July 2026 at the Château de Fontainebleau. 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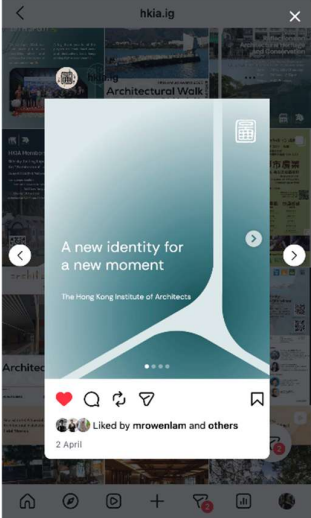
